**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** – For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS** – For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS** – For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

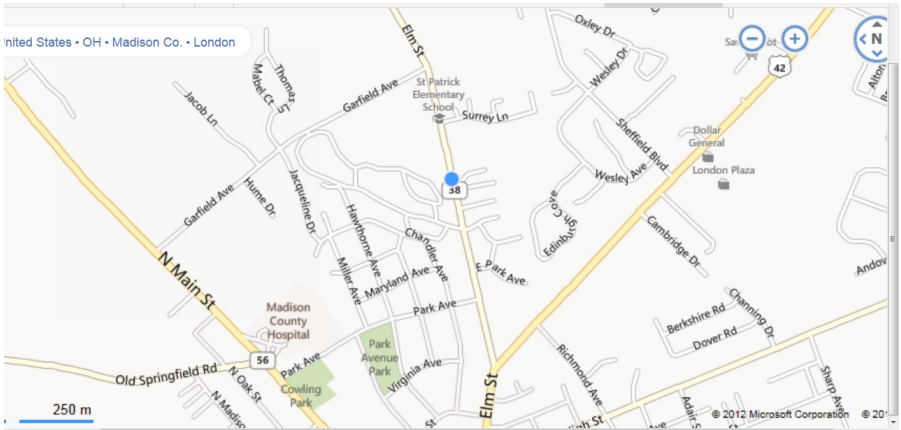

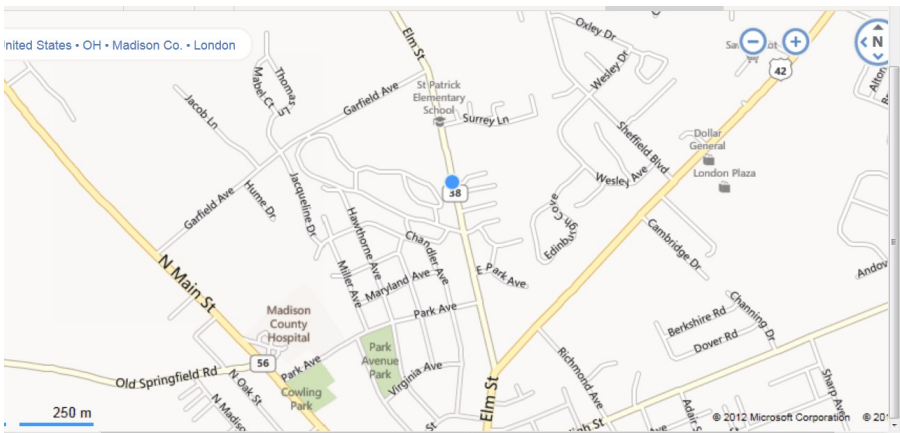

3. **EXPOSURE TO COVID-19:** If you have recently been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for Covid-19 or has the symptoms (coughing/sneezing/temperature) please stay home.
4. **IF YOU ARE ILL, FEEL UNWELL, COUGHING, SNEEZING OR RUNNING A TEMPERATURE:** Please stay home. All show committee members, judges, stewards and workers will be required to self-assess and have temperatures taken. **ALL attendees should self-assess daily.** Report to show committee if you exhibit any signs or symptoms of Covid-19
