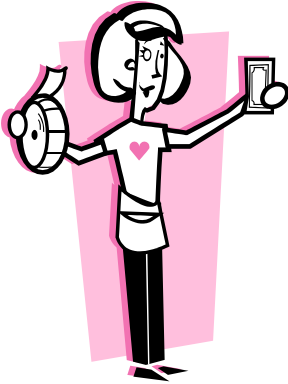

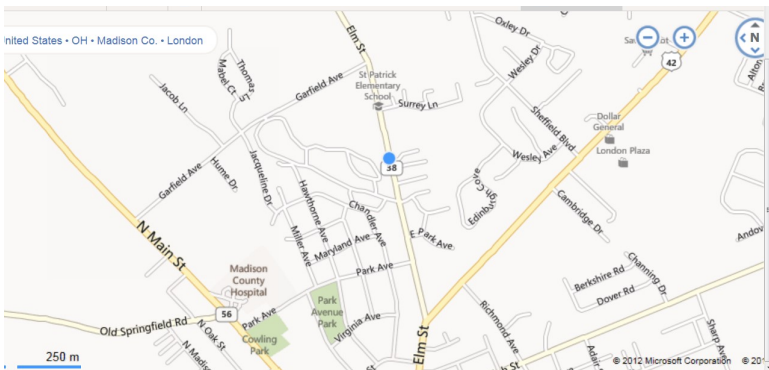

**From Columbus, Cleveland and points NE:** Exit off Interstate 70 at St. Rt. 42 (Exit 79). Go Southwest on St. Rt. 42 into London. St. Rt. 42 deadends into St. Rt. 38 (Elm St). Turn right (at the light) onto St. Rt. 38 (Elm St). Proceed North to the Fairgrounds, which will be on your left.

**From Dayton/Springfield:** Exit off Interstate 70 at St. Rt. 56. Go South towards London. Turn left on CR 136. Go to Elm Street and turn right. The Della Selsor building will be on your right, behind the County Extension Services.

**From Cincinnati:** Exit off Interstate 71 at St. Rt. 38. Go North towards London. Turn right onto St. Rt. 42. Turn left onto St. Rt. 56 at the London Courthouse. Follow St. Rt. 56 to Garfield Ave. The main entrance to the fairgrounds is on the right..



## AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factor.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placement could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those that trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisal of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dogs.
- Sportsmen refused to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed.
