TEMPERATURES WILL BE TAKEN UPON ENTRANCE TO THE SHOW SITE

All of us with the Indiana Collie Club would like to thank you in advance for entering and coming to our shows in the midst of COVID-19. Rules are subject to change. If we all work together, follow all safety protocols and are respectful of each other, we can have a successful, fun and safe dog show! Let’s show the fancy that we can have dog shows safely!

COVID-19 RULES

Indiana Collie Club SHOWS

An inherent risk of exposure to communicable diseases exists in any public place. Communicable diseases can be extremely contagious and/or lead to severe illness and death. Event attendees voluntarily assume all risks to severe illness and death. Event attendees voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to communicable diseases. By attending these events, you voluntarily assume all risk related to exposure to COVID-19 and any communicable disease related to humans and canines.

1. The shows will be closed to the general public. Anyone attending the shows must either be an owner, exhibitor, handler, handler assistant, judge, club member, any hired professional (photo, video, superintendents, stewards, etc.). We recommend no family or friends who are not handling; however, any family members or friends attending the show must enter with an owner or handler of the dog (first time entering) and get an access wristband. General public will not be allowed on the grounds and if found in a building will be politely and professionally escorted off the premises.
2. Masks or Face Coverings will be required in the building at all times. Masks (surgical style) will be provided to all people working the shows. Exhibitors, owners, breeders, handlers, assistants and approved guests will be required to provide their own masks/face coverings. No mask, no entry into the building.
3. Crates are only allowed in designated crating area only. Everyone must stack crates to allow space between exhibitors. No dryers allowed. Small, battery-operated fans permitted, only if aimed directly into crates, and crates must be covered. Please help keep your area clean!
4. Chairs will not be provided. You are welcome to use your own chair at ring side if needed during breed judging. Only those who traveled together can sit together; otherwise, allow 6 feet between when sitting ring side.
5. Please follow all Site Control directions. Armbands will be handed out by one person. Groups will not be allowed to gather around the ring. Please only come to the ring when the class before yours is in the ring. There will be an entrance and an exit to the ring so that those going out of the ring are not within 6 feet of those entering. Please pay attention when exiting the ring.
6. Judges will wear a mask, have hand sanitizer and will sanitize their hands. Judge may choose to wear gloves.

COVID-19 RULES (continued)

7. COME TO THE RING PREPARED! There will be no community catalog ringside. Please be aware of your armband number(s) when coming to the ring.
8. ONLY PREPAID CATALOGS WILL BE AVAILABLE the day of the trial. Include payment with your entry fees and note on the entry form.
9. Food service will be different. Please be patient. We're figuring everything out. We are hoping for a food truck. If not it, we may have to have everyone bring their own food.
10. Please adhere to social distancing at all times.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry without charge, the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress, or harm's way is considered mistreatment.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factor.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placement could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those that trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisal of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dogs.
- Sportsmen refused to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trail has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trail and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trail, howsoever such injuries, death or damages to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner have received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
